The Mission Travel Schedule

Participants are asked to arrive in Dubai by early afternoon local time on Sunday, February 11 (Program will start at 6:00pm). The program will end late in the evening on Thursday, February 15 (approximately 7:00pm). Hotel rooms are included through the morning of Friday, February 16 to accommodate late departures after the Thursday night close or Friday departures. Participants are responsible for booking their own flights to and from the UAE. JFNA will arrange all other travel during the mission.
